Behaviour Expectations

Children attending Dartmoor Makers clubs are expected to:

- Listen to the facilitator and follow any instructions
 - Be respectful to other children and adults in the studio
 - Not be disruptive
 - Use equipment safely
 - Treat materials and tools carefully
 - Help tidy up after activities

Behaviour Support Process

If a child struggles to follow the expectations:

Step 1 – Reminder

Staff will remind the child of the behaviour expected.

Step 2 – Parent Communication

Parents or carers may be informed at collection or by email.

Step 3 – Further Action

If behaviour continues across sessions Dartmoor Makers may:

- Ask a parent/carer to stay for sessions
- Pause attendance temporarily
- In rare cases, withdraw the place
